

PowerPoint Presentations  
Project I: Autobiography  
January 24, 2012

The students will create an autobiographical PowerPoint presentation to be presented orally (speech #1) to their classmates and viewed at parent/teacher conferences by their family. The PowerPoint will chronicle their life from birth to present and is required to include the following:

Slides - A minimum of 7 slides with **transitions**

WordArt Titles - minimum of 4 (**two vertical, two horizontal**)

Clip Art/Animations - minimum of 4 - No more than 1 per slide

Animation - **SOME** titles/ovals/text/clip art/pictures/animations should be animated

Bullets - Must be at least **two** bulleted lists with customized color and character

Scanned photos - minimum of 10 - must fit topic of slide

Background - that matches personality or is visually appealing with slide objects (pictures/text/word art, etc.)

Font - Choose one font and stick with it throughout presentation

Font should be readable and match content

All titles should be same size

All text box items should be same size (captions)

All bulleted list items should be same size

Custom ClipArt - Use the basic shapes on the ribbon to create one custom clipart that matches a topic area - must be **grouped**.

Spelling/Grammar - Proper spelling and grammar **must** be used

Sound -at least **one recorded** sound to match content (topic of page or animation on page)

Be as creative as possible. The presentation may not include inappropriate photos or encourage the use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs.

Please remember that your PowerPoint is a prop only--Do not use any complete sentences. You are the presenter and the PowerPoint is meant to enhance what you are talking about.

Humor is welcome, but information must be factual.
