Guterl, Fred. (Represents the author's last name, first name)

"Understanding Cancer Treatment." (Represents the title of the article - info.)

*MayoClinic.com*. (Represents the title of the site - in italics)

Mayo Foundation for Medical Education and Research. (Represents the organization sponsoring the site (Copyright holder)

4 Dec. 2002. (Represents the date of publication of the article on the site)

Web. (Represents the fact that this source came from the web)

3 March 2004 (Represents the date of access -found on printed out source)
