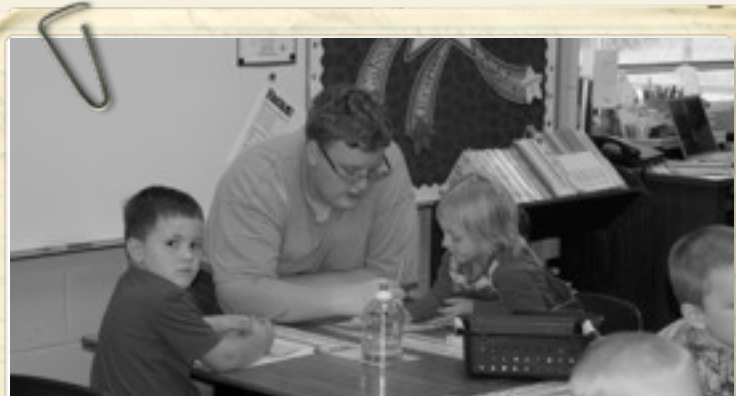
Go Wild with Family & Consumer Sciences

Other Highlights

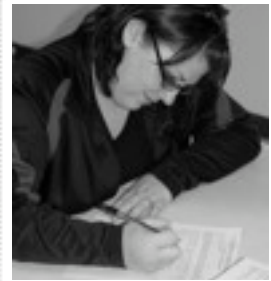

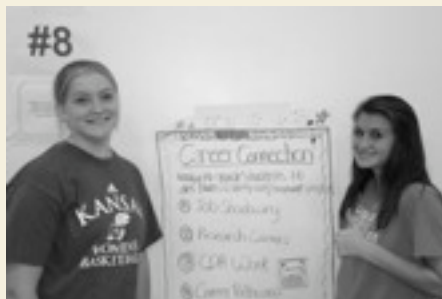
